This role is to mobilize communities to access HTS services at the mobile sites, provide daily mobile HIV testing and pre & post counselling, TB screenings and to educate clients on how to live a healthy sexual lifestyle based on Biblical principles. They encourage everyone to know their status, test for HIV and refer where appropriate. They also prepare HIV positive clients for treatment and teach on the importance of adherence.

**Requirements for the Job:**

- Registered Nurse qualification
- Registered with SANC
- Be able to speak fluent English and Xhosa – which is relevant to geographical area
- Candidates should be resident in the area / surrounds and have good knowledge of the geographical area
- Able to move independently within the local communities
- Must be committed, honest, reliable and dependable with sober habits
- High integrity and confidentiality
- Have good inter-personal communication skills and be willing to work as part of and supervise the health care team
- Able to work flexible hours, and at times to be available on a Saturday or Public Holiday
- Ability to work under pressure
- Administrative and time management skills
- Knowledge of public health and community resources
- Valid drivers license and at least 1 years driving experience

**Duties:**

1. Setting up scheduling of the daily testing sites and obtaining the necessary permissions to be at each site
2. Oversee all HCT services and staff at the mobile HIV testing sites
3. Provide clinical services at mobile sites
4. Ensure administration around clients assessment forms and registers are signed off.
5. Ensure follow-ups of clients referred to clinics for HIV/TB services
6. Work with the project manager in order to realise the aims and objectives of the project – weekly meetings
7. Establish and maintain sustained networking relationships with relevant stakeholders
8. Support, monitor and evaluate project activities
9. Monitoring and supervision of staff, including HR related administration
