The goal of a **Community Health Worker** is to prevent unplanned visits to health services through high-quality and appropriate care that helps the user population to maintain their independence and achieve the best possible quality of life.

Requirements for the Job:

- Grade 12 and a demonstrated level of literacy (both written and numerical)
- Home Base Care and First Aid Certificate (Level 1) or equivalent.
- HTS training and experience, HIV counselling and finger-prick (rapid testing)
- Be able to speak fluent English and one other language specific to their geographical area
- Candidates should <u>be resident in the area</u> Cambridge and have good knowledge of the geographical area.
- Able to move independently in the community
- Must be committed, honest, reliable and dependable
- Have good inter-personal communication skills and be willing to work as part of the health care team
- Ability to work under pressure
- Basic administrative and time management skills
- Knowledge of public health and community resources
- Desire to serve Jesus in a practical way

Duties:

Manage allocated patients and households by conducting scheduled home visits in order to:

- 1. Provide holistic nursing care to clients and families and community
- 2. Educate clients and families about basic health care issues
- 3. Education around HIV/AIDS and TB and the importance of medication and adherence
- 4. Support the Professional nurse in delivering care to clients
- 5. Provide optimal physical care to clients
- 6. Network with local clinics, churches and relevant stakeholders within the community
- 7. Present outcome of each home visit of patient daily
- 8. Data collection/administration, complete required daily, weekly, monthly records and forms.
