Requirements for the Job:

- Diploma in Agriculture or equivalent and / or practical farming experience in a diversified or small-scale agricultural environment
- Computer literate – MS Office 365 proficiency
- Basic budgeting and administration ability
- Proven experience and skills in planning for, organising and managing all aspects of the programme
- Experience in supervising, mentoring, or training others
- Good planning, organisational, and communication skills
- A teachable, self-motivated, and hands-on approach
- Must be fluent in English and one other language relevant to the area (Afrikaans / Xhosa)
- Must have a valid driver's licence and driving experience
- A desire to serve God and people in a meaningful and practical way.

- Responsible for quarterly goals and metrics related to the programme
